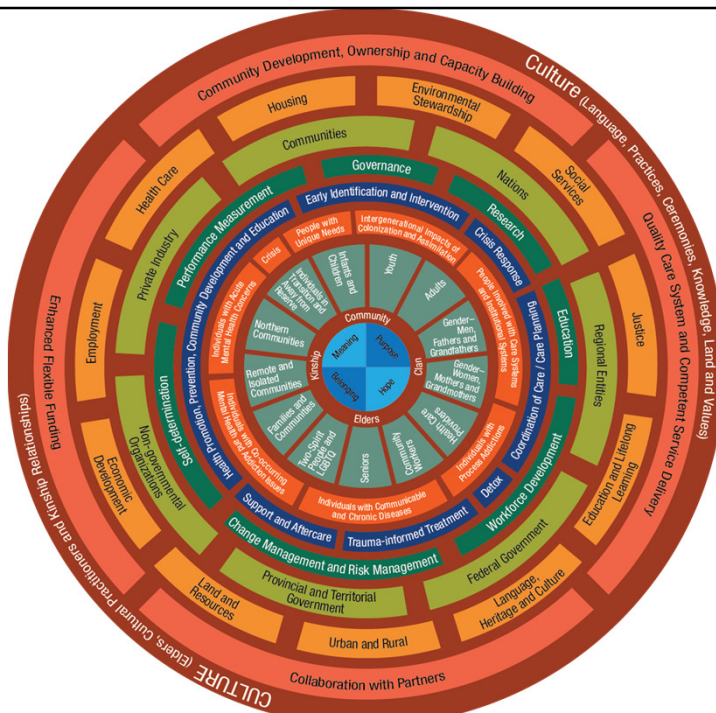


Figure 1.1 A Model of the Determinants of Health

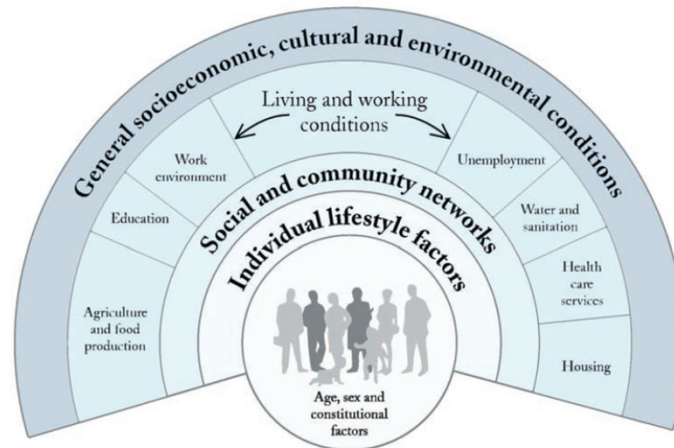
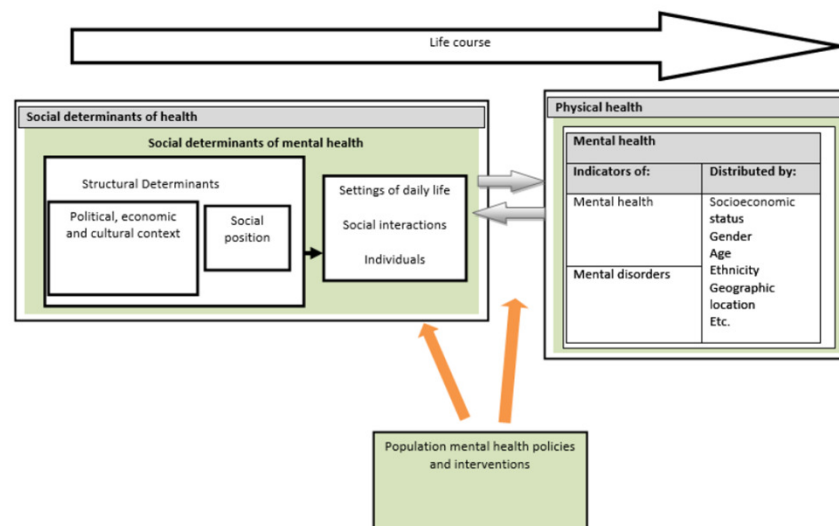


Figure shows one influential model of the determinants of health that illustrates how various health-influencing factors are embedded within broader aspects of society.
